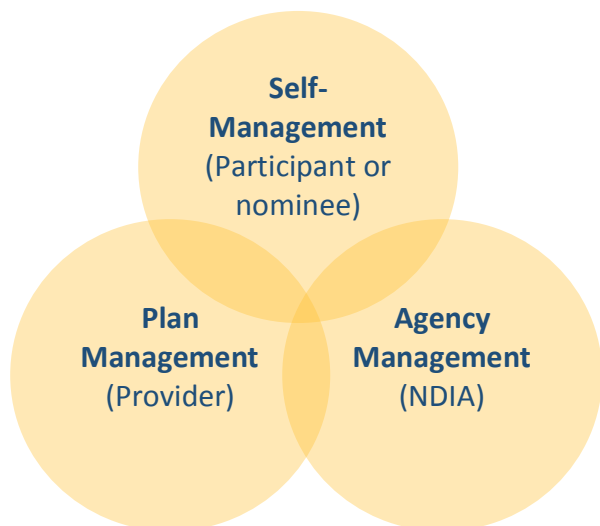




# NDIS PLAN MANAGEMENT v1.0

During the Plan Development stage, it is essential you understand the options to managing your child’s funded plan before you select your preferred plan management option/s.



### It’s important to understand:

- Different options can be chosen for different supports.
- National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) can limit self-management where there is financial or personal risk.
- Plans may have a combination of Plan Management options.

OPTION	PLAN MANAGEMENT DESCRIPTION
<b>Agency Management</b> (NDIA) Approx 70%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The NDIA pays the service providers that the participant chooses to support them in their plan.</li> <li>• The participant can only choose NDIS-registered service providers.</li> <li>• The participant is still responsible for setting up service agreements with each provider and negotiating how, when and where the service will be provided.</li> </ul>
<b>Self- Management</b> (Participant or nominee) Approx 7%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The participant pays all of their own invoices for the service providers and supports that they receive and then claims the money back from the NDIA.</li> <li>• The participant can choose any service provider. They do not have to be NDIS-registered.</li> <li>• The participant’s obligations under this approach include: - setting up service agreements with each provider they choose - paying their invoices on time - keeping track of receipts and invoices that are related to NDIS spending - regularly reporting how much the participant has spent on services.</li> </ul>
<b>Plan Management</b> (Provider) Approx 12%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An NDIS-registered provider, known as a plan manager, manages the participant's NDIS funds and support arrangements.</li> <li>• A plan management service can assist a participant to choose any service provider. They do not have to be NDIS-registered.</li> <li>• A plan management service assists a participant in finding and setting up service providers as well as developing service agreements.</li> <li>• A plan management provider is funded through the participant’s NDIS plan and must be identified at the time of developing their plan.</li> </ul>
