WHO CAN JOIN?

Children aged 4-6 years old and have a diagnosis of Asperger's Syndrome, autism spectrum disorder or PDD-NOS, and their parents.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Social skill deficits are an enduring feature of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). During this group, children will join Evan, Molly, Jesse and Ellie on their adventures to familiar and far-off places (like outer space!) where they explore important social concepts through their thoughts and interactions. This group program aims to teach children social-emotional skills such as self-awareness, perspective taking, social problem solving (flexibly solving problems) and emotions. This group program is based on the We Thinkers! Social Explorers Curriculum, evidence-based materials to develop foundational social competencies.
